Welcome & Introduction to LEGO Participants learn how to use LEGO to build metaphors.

Modeling the Current State The question "*How are we working right now?*" is explored through tangible models.

Agile Values and Principles Concepts such as Scrum, the Agile Manifesto, and Value Stream are built using LEGO.

Designing the Desired Future State Teams work on the question "*What kind of team do we want to become?*"

Barriers and Action Plan Transformation barriers are identified, and concrete action steps are created.

Closing & Sharing Teams present their models and discuss shared insights
